#### FEES

Non Collegiate races are \$30 entry fee for the first race, \$15 for the second. Collegiate Races are \$20 for the first race of the day, \$5 for the second. All racers need a USA Cycling license. 1 day licenses will be for sale for \$10, and annual licenses will be for sale for \$30.

#### DIRECTIONS

Lake Sonoma is about 1.5 hrs north of San Francisco on US-101, about 14 miles west of Healdsburg. Take 101 N to the Dry Creek Rd exit, and make a Left. Follow that road till it makes a 90 degree turn at the base of the dam, then stay on that road up the hill to the bridge. Two miles past that, you will see a sign and the road for Liberty Glen Campground, turn Left. Follow that down, then when the road "Y"s after the toll booth, go to the left. Follow that about an 1/8th of a mile to Campground "E".

#### CAMPING

We have reserved spacious Group Campsite E where registration is located. Facilities include: covered picnic tables, charcoal grill, primitive toilet. No drinking water available. Bring plenty of water for the weekend. If you want more private camping there are plenty of spots available that are \$10/night. If you want to stay in civilization with a roof over your head, there are hotels in Healdsburg or Santa Rosa, approximately 30 minutes from the course. The gates to the campground officially close at 10 pm, but they will be kept open until midnight on Friday night for the SoCal teams.

**Note:** In case of inclement weather, we may switch these events to Sunday and move the Dual Slalom and Short Track to Saturday. **UPDATE: Weather will not alter this schedule.**
